## **Christopher Langman**

Christopher Langman has had a distinguished career in Australia's diplomatic and trade services, holding a range of senior leadership positions across the Department of Foreign Affairs and Trade (DFAT) and the Department of the Prime Minister and Cabinet.

From 2018 to 2021, he served as Deputy Secretary at DFAT, following his appointment as Australian Ambassador to Iraq from 2015 to 2018. Earlier in his career, Christopher played a pivotal role in shaping Australia's international economic and trade policy as First Assistant Secretary of the G20

Policy Division in the Department of the Prime Minister and Cabinet, and as APEC Ambassador and head of DFAT's Economic Division.

He has also represented Australia in key diplomatic posts abroad, including as Ambassador to the OECD in Paris and as Deputy Head of Mission to the United Nations in Geneva. Throughout his career, Christopher has led major trade negotiations, environmental diplomacy, and multilateral engagements.
