She is Founder and Managing Director of the Australian Services Roundtable (the peak business body for the services sector in Australia) and co-convenor of the Asia Pacific Services Coalition. She has taught in the executive MBA programme at the Chinese University of Hong Kong and holds a Senior Visiting Fellowship at the Institute for International Trade, University of Adelaide.

Formerly a senior diplomat and trade negotiator with the Australian Department of Foreign Affairs and Trade, she served on the original Taskforce for the establishment of APEC, as Minister and Charge d'Affaires at the Australian Mission to the EU, as Chief of Staff to the Opposition Spokesman on Foreign Affairs and Development Cooperation, as Chief Economist and

Assistant Secretary, Economic Affairs Branch; Services and Intellectual Property Branch; and Middle East and Africa Branch. Jane started her career with the Australian Treasury, and has spent 2 years with the Commonwealth Secretariat in London, 8 years with the OECD in Paris and 2 years with the International Trade Centre in Geneva.
